Muru (M)

Running Time: 105 minutes

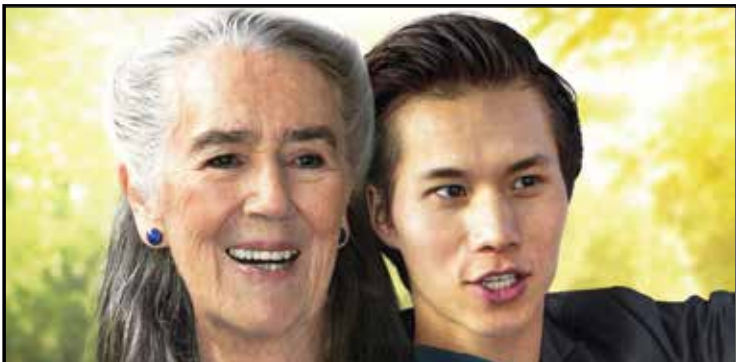
Set in 2007, *Muru* is based on a real event - a raid by the New Zealand Government's elite Special Tactics Group on a remote Māori township as they search for evidence of terrorism. *Muru* is the story of a local Police Sergeant 'Taffy' Tawharau (**Cliff Curtis**), who must choose between his badge and his people.



Good Luck To You, Leo Grande (M)

Running Time: 97 minutes

Nancy Stokes (**Emma Thompson**), a retired schoolteacher and widow, is yearning for some adventure, some human connection, and some sex. Good sex.



A Stitch in Time (M)

Running Time: 98 minutes

A heart-warming story about former dressmaker Liebe (**Maggie Blinco**), who reinvents herself after befriending young Chinese fashion designer Hamish (**Hoa Xuande**). Inspired by Hamish, Liebe decides to make clothes again to support husband Duncan financially, but quickly reignites a long-forgotten passion for her craft. From the executive producer of *Ladies in Black* and writer/director **Sasha Hadden**, *A Stitch In Time* is an ode to the power of community and friendships that come from the most unexpected places. Liebe's touching story will remind audiences of all ages that it is never too late to follow your dreams.



The Railway Children Return (PG)

Running Time: 95 minutes

The Railway Children Return is an enchanting and heart-warming adventure for a new generation. **Jenny Agutter** resumes her role as Bobbie from the original film and is joined by **Sheridan Smith**, **Tom Courtenay** and **John Bradley**. When the children discover injured American soldier Abe (**KJ Aikens**) hiding out in the railyard at Oakworth Station, they are thrust into a dangerous quest to assist their new friend who, like them, is a long way from home.

Lancaster (Ex)

Running Time: 110 minutes

Lancaster tells the story of the iconic World War II bomber, through the words of the last surviving crew members. Starting with 'The Blitz', we follow our 38 contributors as they join-up, learn to fly and go to war. With the enemy strong and RAF Bomber Command badly equipped, British losses were high. But eventually, the tide turned with the introduction of the 'Lanc'. Designed to take the war to the enemy - and to win it - the Lancaster was both loved and feared. From the firestorms of Hamburg, through the famous Dambuster raids and the still-controversial bombing of Dresden, emotional testimonies tell of courage, fear, friendship and moral ambiguity. For there was a deadly price to be paid in the lethal night skies over Germany - 55,000 aircrew and 600,000 civilians were killed. Such was the cost of defeating the Nazis and restoring peace to Europe.



Gloriavale (M)

Running Time: 89 minutes

Gloriavale is an observational documentary examining the widespread abuse inside the infamous *Gloriavale Christian Community* cult and the institutional failures that have allowed it to continue. Exploring the secretive community through never before seen home video footage, the filmmakers follow the **Ready** family as they mount a ground-breaking legal case against the cult's powerful leaders. Long associated with allegations of sexual and physical abuse, human rights violations and fraud, the true extent of *Gloriavale's* crimes and the cruelty of its leaders is exposed as the **Ready** family risk losing their home, their community and those they love for a chance to bring positive change to *Gloriavale*.
